- 1. The Academic Senate quests that the administrative team provide reasons tting classes and the overall strate for reducing sections and he college budget.
- 2. When possible, fultime faculty scheduled to teacherload courseshould consider deferring those courses to train faculty.
- 3. Full-time faculty shouldconsiderteaching their load during Fall an8 pring semesters and consider noteaching in the summer session or winter interses giving parttime faculty the opportunity to teachourses in summer session and winter intersession
- 4. When scheduling classes for ptinte faculty, department chesi shouldmake transparent and consistent decisions based upon a clearly defined departmental strategy for hiring continuing and new patitime faculty.
- 5. Departmenthairs should make an effort toopide at least one class fpart-time faculty who havebeen and wish to continue teaching in the department
- 6. Departmenthairs should make every effort to prioritize those asses that need to be offered as part of the curriculum, including classes usually taught by tipe tfaculty.
- 7. Each departmens thould consider preserving the depth dometadth of its class offerings. They should keep classes the tow students to finish their ademic goals in a timely manner; give students a variety of courses, offer different modalities and access options.
