	#LANTITE SUPPORT <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For students who fail LANTITE it is recommended to undertake Education Elective course EDST2094 Communication Skills for Teachers in Year 2, T2 or T3 before reattempting LANTITE and then complete their second General Education course in Year 4, T1 For students who pass LANTITE, they can complete General Education in Year 2, T2 or T3 and then choose either 6uoc Education Elective; EDST4096 Responding to Gifted & Talented Students OR EDST2032 Critical Issues in Education in Year 4, T1
Professional Placement: **Students are only permitted to enrol in the main offering terms listed for professional placement courses; EDST2002 Professional Engagement / EDST6760 Professional Experience 1 / EDST6765 Professional Experience 2. EDST6765 cannot be studied concurrently with another course
