SECTION 2: Amendments to the Constitution

Clause 1: Amendments to this Constitution shall be placed on the ballot at a general ASB election or in a special election, if necessary, by a two-thirds (2/3)

majority vote of the Student Senate or by a signed petition of ten percent

in which the petition is filed.

Clause 2: Amendments to be submitted to the membership shall have first been

> adequately posted and shall have been printed in at least two consecutive issues of a campus publication, a minimum of two (2) weeks prior to the

scheduled election.

Clause 3: Adoption of amendments to this Constitution shall require a two-thirds

(2/3) favorable majority of those legal ballots cast in the scheduled

election.

ARTICLE 8

Initiative, Referendum, Recall, and Removal

SECTION 1: Initiative, referendum, recall, and removal measures may be initiated by the embers (registered students) in the semester in which the petition

is filed. The Executive Cabinet shall call a special election within three (3) weeks after the date the petition is filed. The notice of the recall election shall be posted two (2) weeks prior to the election.

The decision to recall an elected officer will require a two-thirds (2/3) favorable SECTION 2:

majority in the recall election.

ARTICLE 9

Elections and Appointments

SECTION 1: Elections shall be held in accordance with the specific provision(s) of the By-laws

of this Constitution.

SECTION 2: Appointments shall be filled in accordance with the specific provision(s) of the

By-laws.
