





SECTION 2: Amendments to the Constitution

- Clause 1: Amendments to this Constitution shall be placed on the ballot at a general ASB election or in a special election, if necessary, by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Student Senate or by a signed petition of ten percent in which the petition is filed.
- Clause 2: Amendments to be submitted to the membership shall have first been adequately posted and shall have been printed in at least two consecutive issues of a campus publication, a minimum of two (2) weeks prior to the scheduled election.
- Clause 3: Adoption of amendments to this Constitution shall require a two-thirds (2/3) favorable majority of those legal ballots cast in the scheduled election.

ARTICLE 8

Initiative, Referendum, Recall, and Removal

SECTION 1: Initiative, referendum, recall, and removal measures may be initiated by the members (registered students) in the semester in which the petition is filed. The Executive Cabinet shall call a special election within three (3) weeks after the date the petition is filed. The notice of the recall election shall be posted two (2) weeks prior to the election.

SECTION 2: The decision to recall an elected officer will require a two-thirds (2/3) favorable majority in the recall election.

ARTICLE 9

Elections and Appointments

SECTION 1: Elections shall be held in accordance with the specific provision(s) of the By-laws of this Constitution.

SECTION 2: Appointments shall be filled in accordance with the specific provision(s) of the By-laws.
