7. Transfer Credits including Military Credits

Students receiving VA education benefits are required to submit their college transcripts/military credits no later than the end of their first semester. All students need to meet with a counselor to determine the process for verification of credits and how those credits are applied to their educational goals.

8. Requirements for In -State Tuition

Students eligible for GI Bill® educational benefits including the Montgomery GI Bill®tive Duty program (Chapter 30), the Veterans Readiness and Employment program (formerly called Vocational Rehabilitation (Chapter 31), the Post9/11 GI Bill® program (Chapter 33), or VA Education Benefits for Survivors and Dependents (Chapter 35) (effective August 1, 2022) are exempt from paying nonresident tuition regardless of when the veteran separated from the military.

9. Enrollment Certification

Certification for VA Education Benefits each semester is not automatic. Students who wish to receive the benefit must submit the <u>Enrollment Certification Request</u> every semester after signing up for your classes to continue receiving benefitsalong with an updated Educational Plan after registration starts for their classes to be verified by the VA Certifying Official.

10. Enrollment Verification

Beginning in the 20242022 academic year, all Post 9/11 GI Bill® students who receive Monthly Housing Allowance (MHA) and/or kicker payments are required to verify their enrollment to continue receiving their payments.

11. Absence due to Military Service

Students who are members of an active or reserve U.S. military service who receive orders compelling a
